- **No Fishing License** is required for private waters at this time.
- **Polarized Sunglasses**
- **Sunscreen**
- **Hat**
- **Rain Gear**
- **Camera**
- **Bug Repellent**
- **Extra set of clothes** just in case you get wet.
- **Cooler** for your fish.
- **Rods and Tackle** (MRO can rent Rods and Tackle for \$8.00 per person if desired.)

FAQ's

Dates: MRO fishes the spawn yearly from February 1st until May 1st. We are closed May-August but we do open again September 1st – October 15th for fall fishing.

Tipping: Tipping your guide, cooks, and staff is suggested. Many people ask us what is the normal level of tipping. Our suggestion is the following: We recommend tipping what you normally tip (15-20%) when you eat out somewhere. For instance Guides should receive a minimum of \$20-\$30 from each hunter or fisherman for each hunt or fishing trip. Cooks and staff should be tipped a minimum of \$5- \$10 per man per day depending on number of meals consumed. Tips should be directly given to guides at the time of cleaning your game or fish. There is a cooks' tip jar on the bar of the mess hall where guests can leave tips anytime during your stay or you may leave a tip via your credit card upon check out for cooks or guides.

Ice: MRO does supply ice for your game cooler.

Alcohol: MRO does not allow hard liquor*. Only beer or wine may be brought and can only be consumed at the lodge complex. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the field, on the water or in boats.

Fish: MRO actively manages our lakes and from time to time will allow bass to be taken for management purposes. Please ask at the time of your booking to see if bass may be taken during your excursion.

Boats: MRO uses modified pontoon boats for our fishing excursions. These boats are more stable and easier to fish from than standard boats. Although you should have plenty of room please conserve and limit the number of bags and rods you bring so that everyone will have adequate room to move around on the deck.

Cleaning Fees: Fishing Guides will fillet your bass for you for no additional charge. We do not allow live transport of fish.

Cancellation or Reservation Change Policy: You may change your reservation anytime up to seven days before your hunt or excursion date without penalty. If you cancel your trip less than seven days out or do not show up you will lose your deposit forever. If for some reason you change your trip dates less than seven days out you will have a \$50.00 change fee per person applied to your invoice. NO EXCEPTIONS
If MRO has to cancel your hunt due to circumstances beyond our control, we will refund your deposit, but we will not be liable for any expenses you might accrue in preparation for your hunt prior to our cancellation. We do not refund for acts of God, we reschedule if possible.

*Corporate Members who have signed corporate contracts with specific liability waivers may bring hard liquor.
