



### Hunting List:

- **Hunter Identification Card:** (Hunter's Education if required)

- **State of Texas Hunting License:** YOU MUST HAVE VALID TEXAS HUNTING LICENSE upon arrival or we will not allow you to take a gun with you on your hunt. (If you are bird hunting you must be HIP certified and have the State Migratory Bird Stamp and Federal Migratory Stamp except for youth under 16.) If you are in need of a hunting license or for more information you can now go online to and buy your license and stamps:

- **AMMO:**
  - Ducks:** #1's, #2's, & #3's or your choice of steel or non toxic shot.
  - Quail or Dove:** #6 or #7's or your choice of lead shot.
  - Deer or Hogs:** 270, 30-06 or larger. Minimum caliber accepted is 243 or 6 mm.
  - We do not allow handguns for any of our hunts.**
- **Waders** if Duck Hunting.
- **Face mask** for bird hunting and bow hunting.
- **Hunting Clothes** (please no white insignias on camo clothing or hats).
- **Rain Gear**
- **Camera**
- **Bug Repellent**
- **Extra set of clothes** just in case you get wet.
- **Flashlight or head lamp.**
- **Cleaning Knives** for your large game.
- **Cooler(s)** for harvested game.

### FAQ's

**Tipping:** Tipping your guide, cooks, and staff is suggested. Many people ask us what is the normal level of tipping. Our suggestion is the following: We recommend tipping what you normally tip (15-20%) when you eat out somewhere. For instance Guides should receive a minimum of \$20-\$30 from each hunter or fisherman for each hunt or fishing trip. Cooks and staff should be tipped a minimum of \$5- \$10 per man per day depending on number of meals consumed. Tips should be directly given to guides at the time of cleaning your game or fish. There is a cooks' tip jar on the bar of the mess hall where guests can leave tips anytime during your stay or you may leave a tip via your credit card upon check out for cooks or guides.

**Cleaning Fees:** If you would like to have your hogs or deer cleaned by a staff member, when you reserve a cleaner at time of booking the cost is \$35.00 per animal--otherwise the cost is \$55.00 per animal. Please note that if you do not harvest any game we will not charge you for booking a cleaner. By booking in advance we can prepare to have a staff member available for your cleaning needs. Quail cleaning is \$2.00 per bird and Ducks are \$2.50 per bird for breasting or \$4.50 each for plucking.

**Ice:** MRO does supply ice for your game cooler.

**Alcohol:** MRO does not allow hard liquor\*. Only beer or wine may be brought and can only be consumed at the lodge complex. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the field, blinds, or stands.

**Cancellation or Reservation Change Policy:** You may change your reservation anytime up to seven days before your hunt or excursion date without penalty. If you cancel your trip less than seven days out or do not show up you will lose your deposit forever. If for some reason you change your trip dates less than seven days out you will have a \$50.00 change fee per person applied to your invoice. NO EXCEPTIONS  
If MRO has to cancel your hunt due to circumstances beyond our control, we will refund your deposit, but we will not be liable for any expenses you might accrue in preparation for your hunt prior to our cancellation. We do not refund for acts of God, we reschedule if possible.

\*Corporate Members who have signed contracts with specific liability waivers may bring hard liquor.
